Unfortunately, six shots against on the next three ends were only answered by two shots at the final end for a 15-18 loss. Jack Lafford on Rink2, from being tied at 4-4 at the 6<sup>th</sup> end then took four shots on the 7<sup>th</sup> end then a series of singles with little reply put the score at 16-9 at the 16<sup>th</sup> end. Two shots against on the last two ends resulted in a 16-11 victory. On Rink3 Bob Parker took the early shots to be 7-1 up at the 6<sup>th</sup> end but a recovery by their opposition brought the score back to 9-8 at the 10<sup>th</sup> end. Twelve shots to five shots on the remaining ends saw Bob's triple home safely 21-13. Tim Wilkins on Rink4 scored steadily and were 10-4 up on the 9<sup>th</sup> end from which they continued to take singles on most of the remaining ends whilst conceding only two shots and went to the 17<sup>th</sup> end 18-6 in front. Three shots on the last end for the opposition gave Tim' triple an 18-9 win and took the pens. Ted Walker on Rink5 scored well and were 14-4 in front at the 14<sup>th</sup> end. Dropping eight shots on the next two ends took the score to 14-12 before gaining two singles at the final two ends and eventually won by 16-12.

The return fixture next year will be at Kidlington where no doubt they will seek revenge.
